




Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War

Capt. George A. Cribbs Camp 276



The Capt George A. Cribbs GAR Post 276 was named in honor of Captain George Ames Cribbs. The GAR was founded in 1866 and was dissolved when the last member passed in 1956. The SUVCW was established in 1881 to preserve the history and principles of the GAR. When we organized in 2023, it was only fitting that we be chartered as Capt, George A. Cribbs SUVCW Camp 276.

He was born in Hempfield Township on April 15th 1820. Mustered into Co I, 11th Pa Vol Inf on August 28th 1861. Mortally wounded at the second Battle of Bull Run on August 30th 1862. Died of his wounds on September 18th 1862 at a hospital in Washington, DC.
